Rate Ranges & Application Volumes

- Standard Rates
 - Ground = 16 oz/A
 - Can be banded early season to reduce cost
 - Aerial = 2 pts/A

- Spray Volumes
 - Ground = Minimum of 10 gal/A
 - Aerial = Minimum of 3 gal/A






Spider Mite Test 1 3, 7, and 11 DAT Chart Number/5 sq. in. (2006)











Spidermite Control in Cotton

Info

- Control multiple mite species
- Moderate safety on beneficial mites
- Spectrum of Control
 - Mites
 - Psylla
 - Whitefly
 - Thrips suppression



- Rate Differences from Artisan
 - 3 lb ai/Gal vs 3.8 lb ai/A
 - 32 oz/A Artisan = 25 oz/A Convoy
 - 26 oz/A Artisan = 20 oz/A Convoy
- Soil Disease Control
 - Control of White Mold/Southern Blight
 - Controls Rhizoctonia spp. (limb, stem, peg rots)
- Allows Flexibility in Leaf Spot program
