PRE = Preemergence At-planting or before crop emerges



PPI thru PRE Residual Herbicides

Advantages

- Possible prevention of early-season weed competition
- Provide more time for 1st POST herbicide application

• Disadvantages

- More \$
- Possibly another tractor pass
- Need some sort of incorporation

Canopy EX, Envive, and Elite

• Envive @ 3.5 oz/A

- 1.3 oz/A Classic
- 0.2 oz/A Harmony
- 2 oz/A Valor SX

• Enlite @ 2.8 oz/A

- 0.32 oz/A Classic
- 0.5 oz/A Harmony
- 2 oz/A Valor SX
- Canopy EX @ 2 oz/A
 - 1.82 oz/A Classic
 - 0.27 oz/A Express

- Excellent residual control of ryegrass, bluegrass, prickly lettuce, swinecress, mayweed, geranium species, buttercup, chickweed, dandelion, coneflower
- At Alexandria, provided good control of rhizome johnsongrass and control of many summer annual weeds (barnyardgrass, hemp sesbania, pigweed)

Authority MTZ

- Sulfentrazone + metribuzin Preplant thru PRE
- 10 to 14 oz/A
- 10 oz = 3.6 oz metribuzin
- 14 oz = 5 oz metribuzin

 Excellent control of barnyardgrass, browntop millet, morningglory species, hemp sesbania, redroot pigweed, Palmer amaranth, hophornbeam copperleaf, prickly sida

Prefix

- S-metolachlor + fomesafen Preplant thru PRE
- 2 pt/A
- 18 oz/A Dual Magnum
- 15 oz/A Reflex

- Good to excellent control of barnyardgrass, browntop millet, morningglory species, hemp sesbania, redroot pigweed, Palmer amaranth, hophornbeam copperleaf, prickly sida.
- Sicklepod control fair to good

Others Good Choices

- Command 3ME @ 2 2.67 pt/A
- Treflan @ 1-3 pt/A
- Prowl H₂O @ 1-3 pt/A
- Duai Magnum @ 1-2 pt/A
- Metribuzin 75 DF @ 4.8 to 16 oz/A
- Scepter @ 2.8 oz/A
- Outlook @ 12 to 18 oz/A

- Preplant thru PRE
- Most provide predominately grass control with some control of small-seeded broadleaf weeds
- Metribuzin and Scepter will help on larger seeded broadleaf weeds

Why use them?

• Some may think:


- The price of glyphosate is low!
- I don't want to risk "banging-up" my beans.
- Money is tight. Got to cut corners.
- Glyphosate has always worked for me.

• The benefits of residual herbicides are plentiful


- Reduce early-season weed control
- Buy some time for making 1st postemergence applications
- Help mitigate herbicide resistance

Possible Concerns!

- Glyphosate is cheap in 2010
 - Resistance should worry all of us.
 - Louisiana doesn't want to become like other states

Need to think about possible PP O-resistance
 Overuse of Valor SX, Prefix, Flexst ar, Reflex, Ultra Blazer
 Is metribuzin a good substitute?
