"Variety" is a subdivision of a kind. A variety has different characteristics from another variety (Superior)



#### The originator or discoverer of a new variety may give that variety a name



## Variety What's in a name?

A great deal - if you are talking about VARIETY names!

The term "variety" means a subdivision of a kind that is distinct, uniform & stable, characterized by growth, yield, plant, maturity, seed, disease resistance, or other characteristics by which it can be differentiated from other varieties of public knowledge. It's the type of information you need to determine if it would grow well on your farm or in your crop rotation. You need to know the variety to be sure you are spreading your risk" from unknowns such as disease insect pressure.





#### It is illegal to change a variety name once the name has been legally assigned



Industry labeling trend is labeling products as a "Brand" or with a product number




"Brand" or trademark name must be clearly identified as being other than part of the Variety name



### Optional)

The "Brand" identifies the source – the company that is marketing or selling this seed.

The brand name may be on the label as long as it's not misleading or cannot be confused with a variety name.





# The "Variety" name of the "Brand" must be declared on the seed label


