Why a strong seed regulatory program?

- Seed importing state
- Ensure that seed meets label guarantees and quality standards
- Protect Louisiana's producers against poor quality seed

Regulatory Seed Sampling & Testing

- Collected by LDAF field inspectors
- Agricultural, vegetable and grass seed
- By individual seed lot
- □ 4,015 regulatory samples annually
- 5.13% (~200 seed lots) average noncompliance rate over past five years

Seed-Related Complaints...


- Contact your local seed sales rep
- If no resolution... contact your local LDAF field office/representative
- Provide statement, and information about the complaint
- Important to have... copy or picture seed label, sample of the seed, invoice, etc...
- LDAF field staff will investigate the compliant
- Determine if there is a violation of the Seed Law/Regulations

Seed Germination vs. Seed Vigor

Seed Germination Test – "Evaluation of the seed properties that allow emergence and development of a seedling under <u>favorable field conditions</u>."

Seed Vigor Test – "Evaluation of the seed properties that allow rapid field emergence and development of a seedling under a wide range of field conditions."

Comparison of Vigor and Germination

Germination Testing

- Required by State and Federal Laws/Regs
- Required to be stated on product label
- Utilizes standardized AOSA Rules test methods
- Conducted using optimal non- stressful lab test conditions

Vigor Testing

- Not required by State and Federal Laws/Regs
- Not required to be stated on product label
- May or may not utilize AOSA standardized test methods
- Conducted using non-optimal very stressful lab testing conditions

Seed Vigor Tests - Examples

- Accelerated Aging (aka AA Test) Utilizes high heat (104F) and high humidity to stress the seed (soybeans, sorghum, others)
- Cool Test (aka Texas Cool Test) Utilizes extended uninterrupted period of constant cool temperature (64F) to stress the seed (*cotton*)

• *Cold Test* - Utilizes cold test temperature (50F) to stress the seed (*corn, rice*)



Warm Germ + Cool Germ = Vigor Score

Direct-to-Farm Seed Sales/Shipments –

LDAF has NO statutory authorization to sample or enforce seed regulations on seed purchased directly outside of the State and shipped directly to the farmer.

To help protect yourself in case of any future seed quality issues...

- Keep a copy or photo of a seed label for EACH seed lot in the shipment
- Keep a small (e.g., quart zip loc bag) identifiable/traceable seed sample for EACH seed lot in the shipment and store sample in a climate-controlled area out of direct sunlight

If you wish to voluntarily have LDAF sample your seed shipment for a fee...

- DO NOT open or break the manufacture seal on the seed containers
- Contact and coordinate an onsite visit by LDAF staff in your area to pull an "unofficial official" seed sample to be tested by the LDAF Seed Lab
- Provide the LDAF inspector all requested documents pertaining to seed shipment
